Computers for Children of Under-Served Families

“Every Home A Classroom”™ is a Referral Program to ensure all families with school-aged children have access to a personal computer in the home.

A Free Internet-Ready Computer System will be provided to under-served families that do not have computers in the home. This computer will be fully functional with licensed software and will include a CRT monitor, keyboard, mouse and CDROM. This is at no cost to the recipient.

In Return for Receiving the Computer System, the family that receives the computer is asked to perform a combined total of **40 hours of community service** with a local school or non-profit organization of the families choosing.

Referral Process:

Referral of eligible families to ComputerCorps can be made through public or private education, religious and human service agencies or from individuals from the community. Referring organizations, agencies or individuals can simply call or email ComputerCorps, or download the referral forms online.

Referral Instructions

Program Description

ComputerCorps' "Every Home 'A' Classroom" program provides financially disadvantaged families with school-aged children with an Internet-ready computer and general-purpose applications software.

Eligibility

To be eligible for an "Every Home 'A' Classroom" system, a family must meet the following requirements:

- A family must have one or more school-age children eligible for public, private or home-school primary education. This includes children who may be currently in a 'suspended' or 'expelled' status.
- A family must not have a working computer already in the home.
- A family must be unable to afford a computer.
- All members of the family that plan to use the computer, age 10 and older, are requested to perform a combined total of 40 hours of community service with a private or public non-profit agency or school of their choice. The community service must be performed prior to the family has receiving their computer.

Who Can Refer Families

Any public or private education facility, religious or human service agency, educator or counselor can refer a family.
