Referral Instructions

Program Description

ComputerCorps' "Every Home 'A' Classroom" program provides financially disadvantaged families with school-aged children with an Internet-ready computer and general-purpose applications software.

Eligibility

To be eligible for an "Every Home 'A' Classroom" system, a family must meet the following requirements:

- A family must have one or more school-age children eligible for public, private or home-school primary education. This includes children who may be currently in a 'suspended' or 'expelled' status.
- A family must not have a working computer already in the home.
- A family must be unable to afford a computer.
- All members of the family that plan to use the computer, age 10 and older, are requested to perform a combined total of 48 hours of community service with a private or public non-profit agency or school of their choice. The community service must be performed prior to the family has receiving their computer.

Who Can Refer Families

Any public or private education facility, religious or human service agency, educator or counselor can refer a family.
