- Days & Hours: Monday - Friday • 1:30pm to 4:30pm.
- Space is limited to 16 students ages 9-15 in each camp.
- Registration of \$490 for a 2-week camp that includes a computer system, camp shirt & hat, graduation ceremony and a lifetime of learning. Friday Graduation is from 5:30 to 6:30pm.
- Some Partial Scholarships are available for families in need.

"Every Home 'A' Classroom"™ Summer TechCamp 2K26 Details

- ❖ **Days:** Monday - Friday **Hours:** 1:30pm – 4:30pm (6:30pm on the last day of camp for graduation).
- ❖ Students are expected every day of the 2-week camp.
- ❖ **Space is limited to 16 students per camp and is reserved by receipt of registration fee.**
- ❖ Entire fee of **\$490** is required prior to start date. (Some partial scholarships & early pay discounts are available).
- ❖ Registration fee includes a ComputerCorps Camp Shirt & Hat, Camp Logbook, a Windows 11 complete computer that is customized by the student during the 2nd week of camp, graduation dinner, awards and prizes.
- ❖ The registration fee is treated as a donation to ComputerCorps and is not refundable.
- ❖ Checks are to be made payable to: ComputerCorps, PO Box 21550, Carson City, NV 89721.
- ❖ ComputerCorps is a volunteer-based organization and as such, all students are signed up and treated as volunteers and are expected to comply with the camp rules and volunteer guidelines.
- ❖ Each student earns **daily points based on attendance**, attitude, quizzes and team activities. During the **graduation ceremony on the last day of camp (5:30pm – 6:30pm)** prizes (such as additional hardware and upgrades) may be awarded based on points earned by the students. **Computers are released at the end of the ceremony.**

"Every Home 'A' Classroom"™ Summer TechCamp Schedule

- ❖ **Week 1:** Learn how to dismantle & assemble computers and components, for repaired or eCycling, identify and understand how computer components work to make a system.
- ❖ **Week 2:** Learn how to trouble shoot, customize and test your own computer. Explore tech, security challenges and opportunities for individual projects & presentations.
- ❖ **Graduation Dinner & Awards:** 5:30 – 6:30pm on the last day of each TechCamp. Casual dress. Spaghetti dinner. Family and friends invited. Pick up and take home the student's computer system at the end of the ceremony.

Directions to ComputerCorps TechCamp – Carson City

Our Carson City Community Technology Learning Center (TLC) is located at 4630 Hwy 50 E #1 Carson City NV. **Directions from Reno:** Take Hwy 395/580 Freeway south to Hwy 50 E. Turn east on Hwy 50 to 4630. Turn left to ComputerCorps parking lot next to the Post Office. **Directions from Minden:** Take Hwy 395/580 North to Hwy 50 E. Turn right on Hwy 50 E to 4630) Turn left into ComputerCorps parking lot next to the Post Office.

Volunteer Guidelines and TechCamp Rules

The ComputerCorps mission is to provide access to computer technology and skills training for under-served families, while eliminating electronic scrap (eScrap) in our nations' landfills. All camp, student and volunteer activities are to be performed with the spirit of teamwork, co-operation and kindness. Campers, students and/or volunteers not adhering to the guidelines and rules will be asked to leave. Fees, donations and/or deposits **are not refundable**.

- ❖ Your conduct must always be in a respectful and courteous manner.
- ❖ Foul language, disruptive or destructive behavior and/or horseplay will not be tolerated.
- ❖ Friends (not in the camp) are not to be on the property.
- ❖ Cell phones are not allowed but can be kept in the front office.
- ❖ Any form of illegal activity (alcohol, drugs, theft, etc.) will result in dismissal from camp.
- ❖ ComputerCorps adheres to the strictest software anti-piracy policies and software is not to be copied.
- ❖ All students and volunteers must wear the appropriate nametags, ID badges and safety gear.
- ❖ **Dress:** Casual, comfortable camp clothing and shoes. **NO OPEN TOED SHOES. No loose jeans.**
- ❖ **Parents must pick up their student at 4:30 p.m. NO EXCEPTIONS**
